

Tuition fees

In France, international students from countries outside the European Union (non-EU) must pay differentiated tuition fees at public higher education institutions under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Higher Education.

Non-EU students may be granted partial or total exemptions from differentiated tuition fees by these institutions. You should therefore check the tuition fees directly on the websites of the universities you are interested in.

Private schools apply their own fees. You should therefore check their fees on their respective websites.

In addition to tuition fees, students must pay a €105 CVEC (Contribution to Student and Campus Life).
